Ādāb of Du'ā'

- Q1 Mention one Quranic verse with regards to Adab of making Dua (2)
- **A -** "When My servants ask you about Me, then (tell them that) I am near. I respond to the call of one when he prays to Me: so they should respond to Me, and have faith in Me, so that they may be on the right path." (Qur'ān 2:186)

"Your Lord has said, 'Call Me, I will respond to you." (Qur'ān 40:60)

- "...Or the One who responds to a helpless person when he prays to Him and removes distress." (Qur'ān 27:62)
- **Q2** Mention **seven** Manners which we should try do do when making Dua (7)

A -

- 1) Face the Qiblāh.
- 2) Be in the state of wudū.
- 3) Do a good action before you begin.
- 4) Raise your hands level with your chest.
- 5) Glorify Allah by reciting various praises such as Subhānallāh and Alhamdulillāh.
- 6) Recite şalawāt 'alan nabī.
- 7) Focus on who you are speaking to: Allāh the Creator of all.
- 8) Beg Allah with humility.

- 9) Ask forgiveness for all previous sins.
- 10) Try to cry whilst making du'ā'.
- 11) Pray for yourself first, thereafter make du'ā' for other members of your family.
- 12) Ask Allah through the du'ā's mentioned in the Qur'ān, as these are like registered prayers which have already been used and have been recommended.
- 13) Conclude the du'ā' with the praise of Allāh and şalawāt then wipe the hands over the face.
- 14) Remember to turn to Allāh for every need, for Allāh loves it when His servants ask Him for something. There is no limit to His treasure and there is no limit to His kindness.
- Q3 Mention four different times when Dua is readily accepted (4)
- A Times when du'ā' is readily accepted:
- 1. In the middle of the night.
- 2. On the day of Friday between 'Asr and Maghrib.
- 3. The Night of Power.
- 4. Between adhān and igāmah.
- 5. When drinking Zamzam.
- 6. In Sajdah.
- **Q4 -** Write the meaning of the following Dua (3)

A - "Our Lord, give us good in this world and good in the Hereafter, and save us from the punishment of Fire." (Qur'ān 2:201)

Ādāb of Dressing

Q5 - Mention the Quranic verse with regards to the Adab of dressing (3)

A - "O children of Ādam, We have sent down to you the dress that covers your shame and provides adornment. As for the dress of taqwā (piety), that is the best". (Qur'ān 7:26)

Q6 - Mention **four** Adab of dressing (4)

A -

- 1) Gold and silk are not allowed for males but are permissible for females.
- 2) When dressing, begin with the right hand side and when undressing, begin with the left.
- 3) Do not walk with one shoe only.
- 4) The Beloved Messenger مالية cursed those men who imitate women in their clothing and those women who imitate men. (Abū Dāwūd).
- 5) Modesty is very important in dress: girls should not wear any clothes that reveal their body parts.
- 6) Boys and girls should also ensure their satr is covered at all times.
- 7) Satr for boys is below the navel, including the knees, and for girls it is the whole body except the hands, face, and feet.

Ādāb of Guests & Hosts

Q7 - Mention **five** Adab of guests (5)

A - Ādāb of the guest

- 1) A guest should not inconvenience his host by overstaying.
- 2) Inform the person you are going to visit before you arrive at his house.
- 3) Do not visit too early or too late.
- 4) Keep to the time you were supposed to arrive.
- 5) Seek permission before entering.
- 6) Do not look around the house remember you are not an inspector.
- 7) Do not sit on the host's special place.
- 8) Do not bring up conversations that might offend the person of the house.

Q8 - Mention **four** Adab of the host (4)

A - Ādāb of the host

- 1) We should honour the guests.
- 2) Greet the guest when he arrives.
- 3) Be generous with the guest.
- 4) Aim to prepare special meals.
- 5) Be considerate towards guests, do not force them to eat more than they can bear.
- 6) Follow the guests to the door when they are departing.

Ādāb of a Gathering

Q9 - Mention **one** hadith with regards to Adab of a gathering (3)

A -

Our Beloved Messenger Muḥammad مليالله said, "It is a right of a Muslim on another Muslim when he sees that he wants to sit that he shuffles to make space for him." (Bayhaqi)

"Whenever there are three people together, two should not talk leaving the third person alone, since this may upset him". (Ṣaḥiḥ al-Bukhārī)

Q10 - Mention **four** etiquettes of a gathering (4)

A -

- 1) "Whenever there are three people together, two should not talk leaving the third person alone, since this may upset him". (Şaḥiḥ al-Bukhārī)
- 2) Always remember Allāh and aim to recite durūd (salutations) at least once.
- 3) Sit in any place at the gathering: it shouldn't be a fixed place or inconvenience others.
- 4) Sit closely together, and not far apart.
- 5) "Whenever there are three people together, two should not talk leaving the third person alone, since this may upset him". (Şahīh al-Bukhārī)
- 6) If you see two people sitting together, do not separate them without their permission.
- 7) Repent to Allāh after the gathering.

Ādāb of Istinja

- **Q11 -** Mention **one** Quranic verse with regards to Adab of Istinja (2)
- **A** Surely Allah loves those who are most repenting, and loves those who keep themselves pure. (Qur'ān 2:222)
- **Q12 -** Mention **seven** Adab of Istinja (7)
- A Adāb of Istinjā
 - 1) Enter with your left foot.
 - 2) Cover your hair.
 - 3) Recite the du'ā'.
 - 4) Wash your hands before collecting some water in a bucket or container.
 - 5) Lower the body as much as possible before removing any garments.
 - 6) Make sure your front or back is not facing the Qiblah.
 - 7) Do not talk.
 - 8) Do not urinate whilst standing.
 - 9) Use tissue paper followed by water to ensure you are thoroughly clean.
 - 10) Wipe and wash yourself with the left hand.
 - 11) Wash again with water if drops come out.
 - 12) Ensure no drops of urine fall onto the clothes.
 - 13) Leave with your right foot.
 - 14) Recite the du'ā'.
