20) When you knock on someone's door and they ask "who is it?" what should you not answer with? Who disliked this answer so much?

You should not reply by saying "me" because the Prophet (SAW) didn't like it

21) Say any 5 Adab of entering the house and seeking permission?

When you enter the house greet people with Salam

Don't knock more than 3 times

Knock loud enough that it can be heard without disturbing others but not so quiet that it cannot be heard

Leave a little time between knocks

After 3 spaced knocks enter if you get permission or else leave without thinking bad of the people living there

Don't stand in front of the door. Stand to the right or left

Don't start looking inside the house through the windows or letterbox

Enter with your right foot

Don't speak loudly in a house where people might be resting

If you have the keys then still say Salam so you don't shock or startle anyone

Don't enter a house or room without permission

22) Say any 5 Adab of speaking?

Speak in straightforward and clear words so that people understand

Say only that which benefits the situation

If you are the youngest in a gathering, do not speak unless you are asked to or unless you feel your words will please the host

Do not raise your voice

Do not speak too much that people get tired

When possible, smile whilst talking

When someone speaks to you, listen attentively

Do not interrupt a speaker even though you may know what they are saying

Do not debate something you do not know about

Never utter a word to put others down
