Trust

Q1 - Mention **one** Hadith with regards to Trust (2)

A - Our Beloved Messenger ﷺ said: "Three qualities single out a hypocrite, even if he prays or fasts and claims to be Muslim: If he speaks, he lies. If he makes a promise, he does not keep it. If he is entrusted, he betrays the trust." (Ṣaḥīḥ al-Bukhārī)

Our Beloved Messenger Muhammad ﷺ said, "There is no faith for the one who has no trust." (Ahmad)

Q2 - Mention **three** qualities of a hypocrite (3)

A -

- 1) If he speaks, he lies.
- 2) If he makes a promise, he does not keep it.
- 3) If he is entrusted, he betrays the trust.

Q3 - What was the title given to our Prophet Muhammad ﷺ due to him being The Most Trustworthy? (1)

A - Al-Amin

Q4 - Mention what the **third man** did in the story of the cave (5)

A -

- The third man then prayed to Allāh "O Allah! I hired some workers and paid them their wages, except one of them who went without taking his right (wages). I kept this trust of his and invested his money, purchasing cows money generated a lot of profits.
- After a long time, the man came to me and said, "O slave of Allāh! Pay me my right (wages)." I said, "All that you see is yours - camels, cows, goats and slaves." He replied, "O slave of Allāh! Do not joke

with me." I assured him I was serious. So he took everything and left nothing.

- The man then said, "O Allāh! If I did so seeking Your pleasure, then please relieve us of our distress." The rock slipped aside and they all left the cave, walking freely.

Q5 - There are many categories of Trust. Give **two** examples of Trust (4)

A -

- 1) A person gives us an item to look after, so they have entrusted us and it is our duty to look after it, returning it once they request it.
- 2) Another example is when someone comes to us to ask our advice and trusts us to give them the best advice.

A - When you speak bad about a person to save another person from his harm.

A - That this person will have molten lead poured into his ears on the day of resurrection.

A - Abu Hurayrah (Ra) reports that the messenger ﷺ said, "From the **beauty** of a person's Islam is to **leave** those things that do not **concern** him." (Tirmidhi)

Removing harm from the Road

Q10 - Mention **one** Hadith about removing harm from the road (2)

A - Abū Hurayrah (Ra) reports that the Messenger of Allah ﷺ said, "Removing harm from the road is ṣadaqah." (Ṣaḥīḥ al-Bukhārī)

Q11 - Mention the story that was mentioned in Sahih Al Bukhari (3)

A - There was a person walking one day, and saw a branch which was obstructing the pathway. He decided to move it out of the way to make it easier for other people to pass. Allah loved this action so much that he entered him into Jannah because of this one deed.

Q12 - Fill in the missing blanks (6)

A - Abū Barzah al-Aslami (Ra) said, 'I said, "O Messenger of Allāh show me an action by which I will enter **Jannah!**" He said, **'Remove harmful things from people's path.'**" (Ṣaḥīḥ Muslim)

"Beware of the **supplication** of the **oppressed** one as there is no **veil** between it and Allāh". (Tirmidhī)

Being a Good Neighbour

Q13 - Mention **two** Hadith about removing harm from the road (4)

A -

Our Beloved Messenger Muhammad ﷺ said "Whoever believes in Allāh and the Last Day should be generous to his neighbour." (Mālik)

The Prophet ﷺ said: "The best friend in the sight of Allāh is he who is the well-wisher of his companions, and the best neighbour is one who behaves best towards his neighbours." (Tirmidhī)

Allāh's Messenger ﷺ said, "Abū Dhar when you prepare the gravy, add water to that and give that (as a present) to your neighbour." (Ṣaḥiḥ Muslim)

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ said: "He will not enter Paradise when his neighbour is not secure from his wrongful conduct." (Ṣaḥiḥ Muslim)

Abū Shurayh said that The Prophet ﷺ said, "By Allāh, he does not believe! By Allāh, he does not believe! By Allāh, he does not believe!" It was said, "Who is that, O Allāh's Messenger?" He said, "That person whose neighbour does not feel safe from his evil." (Ṣaḥiḥ al-Bukhārī)

Q14 - Fill in the missing blanks (5)

A -

Our beloved Messenger ﷺ said "A Muslim is the one from whose **hands** and **tongue** other Muslims are **safe** from." (Tirmidhi)

The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said, "He is not a **believer**, who eats his fill, whilst his **neighbour** besides him goes hungry."
