The story of Yusuf (AS) & his family.

Q1 - How many brothers did Yusuf (AS) have? (1)

A - 11 Brothers.

Q2 - Mention the dream that Yusuf (AS) saw (2)

A - One night Yūsuf (AS) saw a dream. He dreamt that eleven stars, the sun and the moon were all bowing down to him.

Q3 - What was the name of the father of Yusuf (AS)? (1)

A - Ya'qūb (AS)

Q4 - After Yusuf (A.S) told his father about the dream, what did his father say? (3)

A - He told Yūsuf (AS) that this was a great dream, and that Allāh would bless him. Ya'qūb (AS) understood how people would react when they saw a blessing with someone else. He told Yūsuf (AS) not to tell any of his brothers for they might become jealous and plan to hurt him.

Q5 - What was the name of Yusuf (A.S) younger brother? (1)

A - Binyāmin

Q6 - Why were Yusuf (A.S) brothers jealous of Yusuf (A.S) and his younger brother? (1)

A - They were jealous because Yaqub (AS) loved Yusuf (AS) and Binyāmin more than them.

Q7 - What did the brothers plan? (2)

A - They thought of a plan that they would throw him into a distant well.

Q8 - What did the brothers say when they came crying to their father in the evening? (4)

A - They came crying to their father in the evening, saying: "O our father! We went racing with one another, and left Yūsuf (AS) by our things, and the wolf ate him, and you will not believe what we say even when we speak the truth." They came with false blood on his shirt.

Q9 - Fill in the missing blanks (2)

A - "(My stance is) **beautiful patience**. It is Allāh, Whose help is to be sought in that (difficulty) which you describe."

Q10 - Who found Yusuf (A.S) in the well? (1)

A - A group of travellers who were on their way to Egypt.

Q11 - What was the name of the minister that bought Yusuf (A.S) ? (1)

A - Qitfir

Q12 - What was the name of the wife of the minister? (1)

A - Zalikha

Q13 - What was the reaction of the women who were cutting fruit, when they saw Yusuf (AS) (3)

A - The Qur'ān tells us their reaction: 'And when they saw him they were taken aback by his beauty and in their astonishment they cut their hands, exclaiming: "Allāh is pure! This cannot be a human. He must surely be a noble angel.'" (Qur'ān 12:31)

Q14 - What did Yusuf (AS) say when Zalikha threatened to put him in prison, if he did not do the evil acts she told him to? (2)

A - "O my Rabb! The prison is more dearer to me than that which these women call me towards (adultery)."

Q15 - Mention the two dreams of the prisoners which they told Yusuf (A.S) about? (3)

A -

- 1) One of them said: "I dreamt that I was pressing wine."
- 2) The other said: "I dreamt that I was carrying upon my head bread from which the birds were eating."

(Qur'ān 12:36)

Q16 - Mention what Yusuf (A.S) said in the explanation of the dreams of both the prisoners. (3)

A -

- 1) One of you will, pour out wine for his king to drink.
- 2) The other one will be crucified and birds will eat from his head.

Q17 - What was the name of the king of Egypt? (1)

A - Rayyan Ibn Walid

Q18 - Mention the dream that king of Egypt saw (3)

A - He saw seven fat Cows being eaten by seven thin Cows, and green ears of corn and another seven dry.

Q19 - What did Yusuf (A.S) say in the explanation of the dream which the king saw? (3)

A - "You shall sow for seven years and that which you harvest, leave it except for a little which you need to eat. After these years seven hard years will come in which you will be able to eat that food which you had kept safe."

"Finally, a year will come when the people will have plenty of crops."

Q20 - What did Yusuf (A.S) do so that his younger brother could stay with him? (5)

A -

- Yūsuf (AS) placed the king's goblet inside Binyāmin's sack and when the brothers were set to leave.
- Yūsuf (AS) made sure that one of his attendants shouted out: "o camel-riders! You are surely thieves!"

- They said, coming towards them, "What is it you have lost?" They said, "We have lost the king's cup, and he who brings it shall have a camel load of goods you know we have not come to do evil in the land, and are not thieves."
- Yūsuf (AS) officers asked, "And what shall be the penalty for it, if you are proven as liars?" They said, "The punishment shall be that in whoever's bag the cup is found that person will be taken as a prisoner."
- Yūsuf (AS) began the search. He searched all their bags, leaving young Binyāmīn's until last. The king's goblet was, of course, found in Binyāmīn's bag.

Q21 - When Yusuf (AS) told his brothers that it was him, what did he say to his brothers? (2)

A - "There shall be no revenge on you! May Allah forgive you and he is the most merciful..."

Q22 - What did Ya'qub (A.S) say to the people around him whilst sitting in Kan'an and what was the reply of the people? (4)

A -

- Ya'qūb (AS) was sitting in Kan'ān and he said to the people around him, "By Allāh I sense the scent of Yūsuf!"
- The people thought he must be speaking through old age. How could Yūsuf still be alive? How could he have survived all these years?
- When the caravan arrived and gave the glad tidings he said, "Did I not tell you I know from Allah that which you do not know?"

Q23 - How many years were Ya'qub (A.S) and Yusuf (A.S) separated for? (1)

A - Forty years.

Q24 - What lessons do we learn from the story of Yusuf (A.S)? (6)

A -

- 1) Allah's plan will always come true.
- 2) Nothing is impossible for Allah.
- 3) Never become jealous, for in the end we will only suffer.
- 4) If someone has been mean to us and then they come to ask for forgiveness we should forgive them.
