Page 1 - True Believer

- 1) A true believer is he who believes only Allah ﷻ alone to be worthy of worship.
- 2) He also declares with his tongue that there is not anyone else worthy of worship besides Allah ﷻ.
- 3) It is evident from the kalimah that we believe one Allah ﷻ and Messenger ﷺ.

Page 2 - True Believer (continued)

- 1) First Kalimah Tayyibah.
- 2) Translation: There is none worthy of worship besides Allah ﷻ, Muhammad ﷺ is the messenger of Allah ﷻ.
- 3) The meaning of the kalimah is this that we do not believe anyone to be lord besides Allah ﷻ.
- 4) Be it an angel or a saint, they too, like us, are the creation of Allah ﷻ and his servants.
- 5) The life and death of the creation of Allah ﷻ happens only with the command of Allah ﷻ.
- 6) Only he gives sustenance to the entire creation.
- 7) Only he gives illness, only he gives cure.
- 8) Only he is the master of the entire world.
- 9) Allah ﷻ has no father, no son.
- 10) Everyone is needy of him and only him.
- 11) He is not needy of anyone.
- 12) Only he helps everyone, is with everyone and is aware of everyone.
- 13) Only he alone is worthy of worship.
- 14) Whoever does not believe Allah ﷻ to be worthy of worship, is a disbeliever.
- 15) After dying he will go into Jahannam.

- 1) And whoever believes anyone else with Allah ﷻ too, he is a polytheist who will not be pardoned.
- 2) Only he is known as a believer who does not make anyone else worthy of worship and only follows upon the command of Allah ﷻ.
- 3) Only fears Allah ﷻ and only keeps hope with him.
- 4) Without this, no action will be accepted; not prayer (Salaah), not fast, not pilgrimage (Hajj) and not charity (Zakaah).
- 5) This very kalimah is the door to the religion of Islaam.
- 6) This very kalimah is the key to Jannah.
