- 2) For this reason, it is compulsory to have the best treatment with parents and their rights are the most of all.
- 3) The service and obedience of the parents has also been emphasised in the Qur'aan.

- 1) It is the saying of Allah ﷻ: "And your lord has already given a clear command that do not worship anyone else besides him, and do favour with the parents. If, in your presence, one of them or both of them reach old age, then do not even say 'uff' in front of them and do not shout at them but speak to them with respect and honour."
- 2) For the sake of the happiness of the parents, there is a command to sacrifice one's comfort, one's desire, everything.
- 3) The disobedience of the parents can only happen when they say to break the command of Allah ﷻ; but with respect.
- 4) Besides that, their command cannot be refused under any circumstances.

- 1) The messenger of Allah ﷺ has also stated this: "Your lord has forbidden upon you the disobedience of the parents."
- 2) To this extent, that if anyone's parents are disbelievers or polytheist then even at that time it is necessary to have good treatment with them.
- 3) Without doubt do not obey any of their saying that is against the deen of Allah ﷻ.
- 4) A sahaabi once asked the messenger of Allah ﷺ: "With who should I do the most good?" The messenger of Allah ﷺ said: "With your mother."  
He asked: "Then with who?". (Nabee ﷺ) said: "With your mother."  
He asked: "Then with who?". (Nabee ﷺ) said: "With your mother."  
Three times Nabee ﷺ gave this very answer.  
Upon asking the fourth time: "With your father."
- 5) For this reason, the right of the parents is compulsory upon us more than all. The right of the mother is more than the father too.
